
WHAT'S GOING ON WITH RATES?

Although interest rates have been increasing at rapid rates, you may have noticed little change to MCECU's deposit rates. One of the priorities of MCECU is to help improve the financial well-being of our members. For most members, increasing our deposit rates would not amount to a significant increase in the amount of dividend deposited to your account and, therefore, would have little impact in your disposable income; however, for those looking to borrow, being able to keep loan rates lower because deposit rates are also lower, can have a huge financial impact when calculating the amount of interest paid over the course of a loan or even just affording a monthly payment. SEND YOUR REFUNDS TO MCECU

When you prepare your taxes or have them filed for you, don't lose out on your hard-earned money by paying charges associated with refund anticipation loans (RAL) or pre-paid cards just to get an immediate refund. E-file your taxes and have your refunds deposited at NO COST to you. Just provide your MCECU account number and routing number, which is 275982322, when you file your taxes, and the refund will be automatically deposited into your account at the credit union.
